Realistic Piano Action

The P-140 features Yamaha's highly acclaimed Graded Hammer Effect keyboard, designed so that the keys in the lower registers have a heavier touch than those in the upper. This is a crucial element in re-creating the touch of an acoustic grand piano which has hammers arranged from large to small across the keyboard.



Stylish Design

The P-140 has a sleek design with rounded corners and rear-mounted speakers. All of this is set into a compact chassis available in either silver or black with wood top panels of maple or dark oak.

Dynamic Stereo Sampling

2-Track Sequencer

An on-board sequencer lets you record an entire performance and play it back with the touch of a button. You can even record a second part using a different voice. The tempo can be slowed down or sped up during recording or playback, which makes this sequencer a great tool for practicing.

64-Note Polyphony

The P-140 uses 64-note polyphony, which ensures that sustained notes won't be cut off abruptly while pedaling during intricate musical passages.
