# **Network Update Method**

STEP1 Plug the AC cable directly to the Music Commander



### STEP2 Perform network update for the Music Commander (MCX-RC100)

From the Music Commander, select the following and start update. **NOTE: Music Commander must be charged 50% or more.** 

Setup > [SYSTEM] > [Firmware Update] > [Network Update] >





Allow about 4 minutes for the update. When completed, Music Commander will restart.

**STEP3** Check updated version of the Music Commander (MCX-RC100) From the Music Commander, select the following and check current version







**STEP5 Perform network update for the Music Player (MCX-A300/P200)** From the Music Commander, select the following and start update.

Setup > [CLIENT] > [SYSTEM] > [Firmware Update] > Network Update] >





Allow about 3 minutes for the update.

When completed, the Music Player automatically restarts and the Music Commander's display returns to the "Zone" screen.

#### STEP6 Check updated version of the Music Player (MCX-A300/P200)

From the Music Commander, select the following and check updated version.

# **USB Update Method**

### STEP1 Prepare USB thumb drive for the update

**Download the corresponding firmware file** for your MusicCAST2 from Yamaha website.

"MCX-RC100\_xxxx.bin" is the firmware for Music Commander (MCX-RC100) "MCX-A300\_xxxx.bin" is the firmware for Music Player (MCX-A300) "MCX-P200\_xxxx.bin" is the firmware for Music Player (MCX-P200)

Then, copy the corresponding firmware files to the root folder of your USB thumb drive. MusicCAST2 will identify the necessary file for the update.



- Note: We recommend that you DO NOT store any other files or documents on your thumb drive during this firmware update
- STEP2 Plug the AC cable directly to the Music Commander



STEP3 Insert the USB thumb drive to the Music Player (MCX-A300 or MCX-P200) USB terminal is located on the rear side





#### STEP4 Select the Music Player which USB thumb drive is inserted.

Press  $\bigcap^{\text{ZOME}}$  on the Music Commander and select



STEP5 Perform USB update for the Music Commander (MCX-RC100) NOTE: Music Commander must be charged 50% or more.

From the Music Commander, select the following and start update.



Allow about 4 minutes for the update. When completed, Music Commander will restart.

**STEP6** Check updated version of the Music Commander (MCX-RC100) From the Music Commander, select the following and check current version.





#### STEP7 Select the Music Player which USB thumb drive is inserted.

Press  $\stackrel{\text{ZONE}}{\frown}$  on the Music Commander and select.



**STEP8** Perform USB update for the Music Player (MCX-A300/P200) From the Music Commander, select the following and start update.
