

# Yamaha MO6/MO8 Voice Editor V2.2.2 for Mac

## Release Notes

Thank you for using Yamaha products.

MO6/MO8 Voice Editor for Mac (henceforth referred to as “Editor”) is a software program that gives you exceptionally convenient and intuitive editing of the various sound and effect parameters of the MO6/MO8. You can easily transfer the edited data to the MO6/MO8, as well as save MO6/MO8 voice data to your computer. In addition, the MO6/MO8 can read the data you have created with this software via USB storage device.

This software can be used on its own as an independent editor, as well as with DAW software that is compatible with Studio Connections and the Recall feature.

### Before installing:

Ensure that the latest Studio Manager is installed on your computer.

### How to check you're the current version:

After starting up the Editor, go to the [HELP] menu -> [Version Information].

### Version History:

#### V2.2.0 to V2.2.2

- Now supports Mac OS X 10.6 Snow Leopard.
- Fixed a problem in which a sound would sustain while using the Virtual Keyboard of Cubase.
- Solved a problem in which Cubase would quit unexpectedly when trying to start up the VST plug-ins for EastWest/Quantum Leap software's Play Edition tone generator series.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.6 to V2.2.0

- Support for Macintosh computers using Intel processors has been added.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.4 to V2.1.6

- The speed of the Recall operation has been improved.
- The Voice Bank display in the Part Mixer screen has been changed to Voice Category display.
- It is now possible to select each Category in the Voice selection for each part.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.3 to V2.1.4

- Solved the problem in which MIDI data could occasionally not be input or output from the editor.
- Solved some minor errors.

#### V2.1.2 to V2.1.3

- Solved the problem in which when opening a settings file (which was created using a stand-alone editor of Studio Manager) in a Studio Connections compatible DAW software application, there was a remote possibility that the MIDI port settings could be altered and would not allow you to change the settings back.

- Solved the problem in which a "Forced Ending" dialog appeared after performing a Recall function.
- Corrected other minor errors
